Metro Atlanta is one of the most important global supply chain centers in the U.S. Atlanta was founded as a railroad hub terminus in 1837 and today is home to the world's busiest airport. Our region is home to distribution centers, offices and headquarters of some of the largest supply chain companies in the country, including Amazon, The Coca-Cola Company, Delta Air Lines, The Home Depot, Norfolk Southern and UPS.

This physical transportation hub is bolstered by world-renowned digital supply chain technology companies; in fact, Deloitte ranked Atlanta as the #3 metro area for digital supply chain in the U.S. Educational institutions like the Georgia Institute of Technology, Georgia State University and Kennesaw State University are producing leading-edge research, graduates and ideas that are shaping the entire industry.



Spotlight: Collaboration Sparks Innovation

In June 2022, the Home Depot announced a collaboration with Georgia Tech's highly regarded Advanced Technology Development Center (ATDC) to create a new program focused on Supply Chain and Logistics startups. As part of a three-year sponsorship, Home Depot executives will mentor program participants and offer guidance and expertise to support their growth.

ATDC is a globally recognized technology incubator and the Supply Chain vertical is the sixth of its kind at the incubator, following other targeted programs in health, retail and financial technologies.
