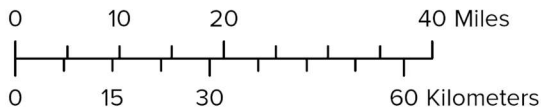
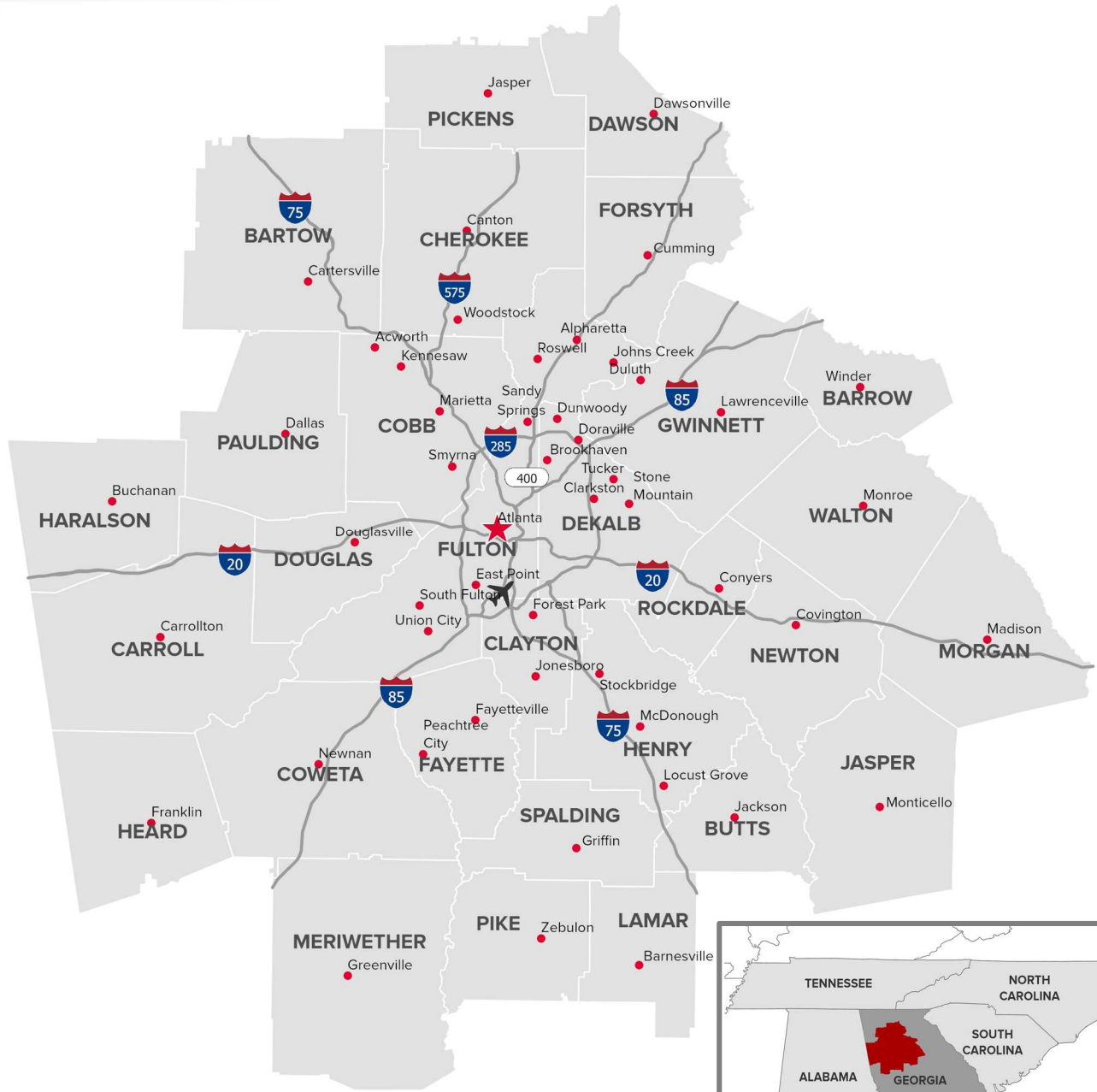




ATLANTA-SANDY SPRINGS-ALPHARETTA, GA Metropolitan Statistical Area
